**Smyrna Baptist Church**, nestled in Parch Corn Holler just North-East of Ozark, Missouri, is the Little Church with the Big Heart. Founded way back in 1890, this Southern Baptist Church is a beacon of hope and comfort in a turbulent world.

### **DIRECTION FROM OZARK (from Business 14):**

*Turn **NORTH** on Riverside Drive and make a **RIGHT** at the Y corner of the Park. Continue **NORTH** to Green Bridge Road. Turn **RIGHT** and follow signs for the Church across the Finley River to the church.*

Folks from many backgrounds gather at Smyrna every week. Sunday School begins at 10AM. **Services at 11AM.** Sunday evening Service, 6PM.

**Reverend Dale Grubaugh**, pastor of **Smyrna** for over 14 years, is grounded in the Christian faith, passionate about God's gift of love and grace. The church has many activities, including Southern Gospel Music and Bluegrass Music events, and Trail Rides to Church (weather permitting). Wednesday night services (and supper) take place every week.
